Instructions for Completing Application for Admission

1. Fill out the application making sure that you cover every item including the term.
2. Return the application with a \$25 (*nonrefundable*) application fee to the Bernard Revel Graduate School/Harry Fischel School at the address given above.
3. You must have one official copy of your transcript of record listed sent directly to Bernard Revel/Harry Fischel from each undergraduate and graduate school attended (*including schools of Yeshiva University*). If this application is submitted in the middle of a semester during which you are in attendance at another school, you should not wait until the end of the term to have the transcript sent; it should be sent and supplements should be requested upon completion of the term.
4. You are to enter your name in the appropriate places on the attached "letter of recommendation" forms and send a copy to three college professors under whom you have studied. Request them to fill out the forms and return them to the above address.
Please supply each referee with a stamped envelope addressed to the school.
5. Upon completion of the application (*receipt of all supporting transcripts and documents*), you may be invited to an interview.
6. An application cannot be processed until all documents have been received by our school and all other requirements have been met.
